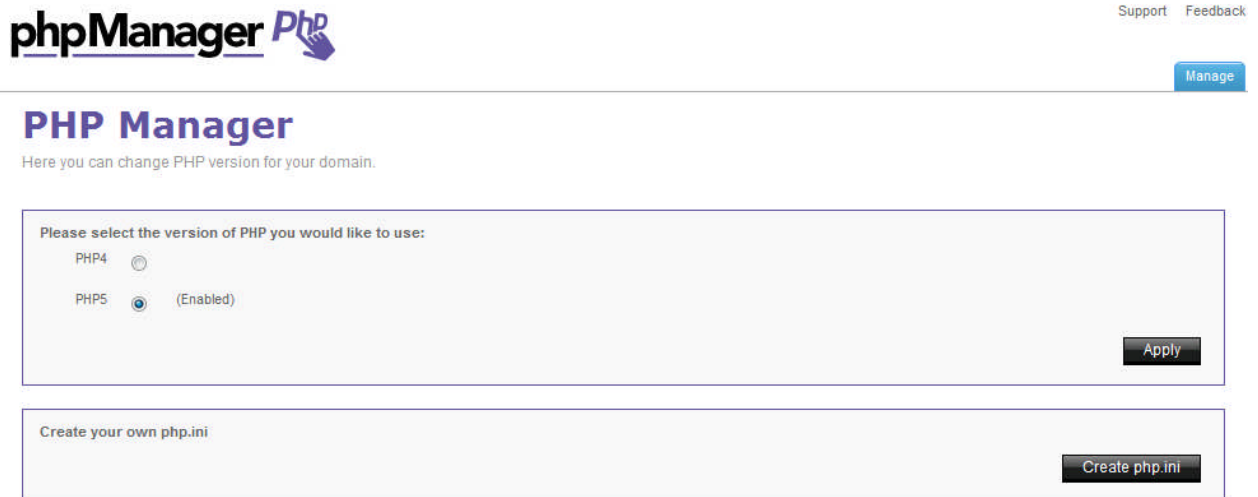
1 Introduction

phpManager allows you to change PHP version for your domain.

TO LAUNCH EASYMAIL SETUP:

- Click on the **phpManager icon**.

The application opens in a new window.

The main menu is located on the top-right corner of phpManager.


- **Main Menu:** links you to the main page within phpManager

You can setup latest or earlier php version and also you can create php.ini file. The php.ini file is the file where you manage setting to your PHP.

TO CHANGE PHP VERSION:

1. Select php version.
